



I would like to take this opportunity to make you aware of a vital volunteer organization known as COPLINE. This non-profit organization is a national hotline that is answered by retired law enforcement officers to assist law enforcement and their families in times of crisis as well as deal with the many psychosocial stressors they face on and off the job. Retired law enforcement officers are trained in active listening skills and bring the knowledge and the understanding of the many experiences that officers have both on and off the job. Active officers and their families can call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and be assured that there is a trained retired officer on the other end of the line. This is strictly confidential for the caller, regardless of whether he or she is calling while on or off duty.

Call takers undergo a stringent vetting process and when selected by the COPLINE board as a candidate, they take an intense 40-hour course aimed at helping them acquire the skills needed to become an active listener and help the callers that utilize COPLINE.

All staff are volunteers, including call takers. At the present time, COPLINE is funded by various fund raisers and the 3rd annual west coast golf tournament is being planned to take place at Singing Hills Golf Course at Sycuan on May 14, 2020. We would love to include you in what will be a great fundraiser and golf event that will be in the format of a Scramble with awards going to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams. Many excellent raffle prizes will also be offered plus a live auction at the dinner after the tournament.

Corporate Sponsorship is \$1,000 and that includes a paid golf foursome, carts, and an awards banquet dinner after the round of golf.
